

**MH Corbin Traffic Analyzer Study
 Computer Generated Summary Report
 City: Kirkwood
 Street: EB Longview
 Location: East of East Essex**

A study of vehicle traffic was conducted with the device having serial number 403954. The study was done in the E/B lane at EB Longview in Kirkwood, MO in St Louis county. The study began on 09/30/2021 at 04:00 PM and concluded on 10/07/2021 at 04:00 PM, lasting a total of 168.00 hours. Traffic statistics were recorded in 15 minute time periods. The total recorded volume showed 1,598 vehicles passed through the location with a peak volume of 14 on 10/05/2021 at [04:00 PM-04:15 PM] and a minimum volume of 0 on 09/30/2021 at [07:45 PM-08:00 PM]. The AADT count for this study was 228.

SPEED

Chart 1 lists the values of the speed bins and the total traffic volume for each bin. At least half the vehicles were traveling in the 25 - 30 MPH range or lower. The average speed for all classified vehicles was 25 MPH with 57.53% vehicles exceeding the posted speed of 25 MPH. 0.00% percent of the total vehicles were traveling in excess of 55 MPH. The mode speed for this traffic study was 25MPH and the 85th percentile was 30.86 MPH.

CLASSIFICATION

Chart 2 lists the values of the classification bins and the total traffic volume accumulated for each bin. Most of the vehicles classified during the study were Vans & Pickups. The number of Passenger Vehicles in the study was 502 which represents 31 percent of the total classified vehicles. The number of Vans & Pickups in the study was 1001 which represents 63 percent of the total classified vehicles. The number of Busses & Trucks in the study was 62 which represents 4 percent of the total classified vehicles. The number of Tractor Trailers in the study was 29 which represents 2 percent of the total classified vehicles.

HEADWAY

During the peak traffic period, on 10/05/2021 at [04:00 PM-04:15 PM] the average headway between vehicles was 60 seconds. During the slowest traffic period, on 09/30/2021 at [07:45 PM-08:00 PM] the average headway between vehicles was 900 seconds.

The roadway surface temperature over the period of the study varied between 63.00 and 124.00 degrees F.
